



BAD BEAT PROMOTION

OFFICIAL RULES

- Texas Hold'em games that take the promo dollar are exclusively eligible for the Bad Beat.
- "Bad Beat" means a qualifying high ranking poker hand that is beaten by a higher ranking hand.
- The pot must be at least \$20.
- A minimum of four players must be dealt in at the start of the hand to qualify.
- A pocket pair for four of a kind is required to qualify.
- Both cards in the hand must be used to qualify for straight flushes and full houses to qualify.
- Payouts of the Bad Beat are approximately as follows:
 - 40% of the Bad Beat will be awarded to the Bad Beat hand (losing hand).
 - 20% of the Bad Beat will be awarded to the winner of the hand.
 - 40% of the Bad Beat will be awarded equally amongst the players on the game who received cards at the beginning of the hand and are present during the deal.
- The hand must go to a showdown in order to qualify for the Bad Beat and eligible hands must be turned face up on the table.
- If there are more than two hands that qualify for the jackpot within one hand, then the two highest hands will be considered for the winner and loser shares of the Bad Beat.
- If two Bad Beats hit at the same time on two different tables, surveillance will review to see which hand "started" first. If they started at the exact same time all payouts will be cut in half and both tables will be paid.
- The Bad Beat Jackpot may be void in the event of the following:
 - Too many or too few burn cards.
 - Foul Deck or too many or too few cards.
 - Cards dealt out of sequence.
 - Cards having left the clear view of the table.
 - Players must play their hands independently. Any discussion of the prize during the playing of the hand may void qualification for the prize. If any player, whether directly or indirectly involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another on how to act or reveals his/her hand to other players, the Bad Beat may be disqualified.
 - The appropriate paperwork must be filled out to receive a payout. A valid I.D. and Total Rewards card is required.
 - Anyone who qualifies for a payout that doesn't provide the proper identification within a reasonable amount of time will not receive a payout and their portion will go back to the promotional money account.
 - Management reserves the right to verify eligibility of all qualifying hands. There may be no recourse if the cards are mucked before surveillance was able to verify the hands and the community cards.

JACKPOT CALCULATIONS:

- Each time the Bad Beat Jackpot is paid out, the pool will start over at \$40,000 on the 1st or 15th of the month (whichever comes first) at 6:00am and the starting qualifying Bad Beat hand will be four 10's beat.
- If the qualifying hand by the 1st and the 15th of each month at 5:59am has not been hit, \$20,000 is added to the Bad Beat along with the qualifying hand being reduced.
- Example: The Bad Beat starts out at four 10's and \$40,000 on the 1st of the month. If it has not hit by the 15th of the month at 5:59am. The Bad Beat will then be a total of \$60,000 and the qualifying hand will be four 9's and so on, until it has been awarded.
 - Progression of qualifying hands:
 - Four 10's
 - Four 9's
 - Four 8's
 - Four 7's
 - Four 6's
 - Four 5's
 - Four 4's
 - Four 3's
 - Four 2's
 - Aces full of K's (Do not have to play an ace in the hand)
 - Aces full of 10's (Do not have to play an ace in the hand)
 - Any Aces full (Do not have to play an ace in the hand)
